ADMISSIONS NOTES

- Kids under the age of two are free to enter the park.
- There will be no discount for children over three and under 48”.
- Season pass-holders do not need to purchase tickets into the park, but if the season-pass holder would like a meal they will need to complete the form and send payment for the meal ticket.
- Tickets are valid only on September 25 for the Diocese of Allentown Family Day and cannot be refunded or exchanged for another day at Dorney Park.

PARKING

- Parking is available at Dorney Park, and there is a \$10 fee per vehicle.

MEAL TICKET

- Your meal ticket includes an “All-You-Can-Eat” buffet from 4 to 6 p.m. at the Diocesan pavilion where Bishop Barres will be there to meet with you. The meal includes: hot dogs, hamburgers with cheese, potato chips, salads, and beverages (Pepsi, Diet Pepsi, Sierra Mist, and Lemonade).

On September 25, Dorney Park will begin celebrating Halloween with a kid-friendly Halloween theme until 5 p.m. The haunted house, Halloween attractions and shows are not recommended for children under the age of 13 and will begin at 5 p.m.
